

Weare Heritage Commission
March 28, 2012
Draft Minutes

Present: Chairperson, Tanya Krajcik; Vice Chair, George Malette; John McCausland, and Secretary, Meg Malette. Lee Marcroft resigned from the commission.

Minutes: Motion to approve as amended, by Tanya and George seconded it. All voted in favor.

- All commission members will be renewing their positions on the commission. George needs to renew his full member position.
- Peaslee Road Bridge – What mitigation does the commission want? Tanya said that it has to be transportation related and benefit the town's people. Could be a walking tour brochure, signage relating to the bridge, Web site, or history of transportation in Weare. The consensus of the Commission is to create a citizen friendly booklet working with the information in the DHR Individual Inventory Form. At the next meeting, we will make it more precise. John will prepare this email with the commission's ideas.
- John Stark Scenic Byway's possible workshop for the state register, presented by the Division of Historical Resources. George would like a workshop that would include information on how to research your historic home. Tanya said that the state register workshop will discuss how to research your historic home's history. George will run this information by the intern at the Southern NH Planning Commission who is connected to the John Stark Scenic Byway Commission.
- The Commission discussed a letter to the residents of the Clinton Grove Overlay Historic District about having an opportunity to meet to discuss zoning changes that would help them to keep the district the way that they want it.
- The Heritage Fund expenditure letter was signed and dropped off to Tina at the Town Office Building. A check will be issued to the South Weare Improvement Society for the work on Osborne Hall. John will follow up with the Town to make sure the check was mailed.
- Piscataquog River Management Plan & The Piscataquog Watershed Land Conservation Plan– George will inform the Conservation Commission and Planning Board that the Heritage Commission recommends approving these plans and adding them as an addendum to the Master Plan.
