JSGFCA & John Stark Generals wish to paint and repair some areas on the Bolton concession stand. This was addressed last season, but not finalized. PARC grants the programs permission to paint and repair the concession stand and to repair the score board controller.

JSGFCA also wishes to possibly put up temporary sponsorship signs if they are able to sell any. Agreed.

WAC expressed concern about Purington Field being driven over and damage caused to the field. PARC was aware of Ineson damage last fall, but no Purington damage. Pete Stockhaus indicated the damage to Ineson Field will repair nicely since it was caught so quickly. Also, wondering about fixing the score board at Bolton. Visibly broken on the front. PARC will take a look to see if there is any contact information on the board itself for repair info.

JSGFCA confirmed that porta-potties and dumpsters would be provided at the fields. Confirmed they would be delivered on or about April 1st. Also confirmed DPW would be out to smooth out the road and entryways to parking areas.

Also confirmed that irrigation will be scheduled. Late to be turned on last season. Times were messed up also. PARC indicated that there were several power outages that caused the timer to reset. Agreed that 4:00 AM and 9:00 PM were good times to have the sprinkler systems set so as not to interfere with morning and evening games and practices.

Tara Mann also in attendance to inquire about becoming a board member. An overview of PARC's role in the community and our responsibilities were outlined. Ms. Mann chose to stay for the remainder of the meeting.
