## II: PUBLIC HEARING:

Expedited Site Plan Review JoAnn Kasper

Little Buttercups Nursery School

Two weeks ago, the Planning Board requested a site plan review for the expansion of the nursery school. The Board reviewed Ms. Kasper's application and septic plans.

Ms. Kasper explained to the Board that she plans to expand the daycare from 15 to 22 children. They will be adding a light on a telephone pole; there will be no additional staff required and no additional parking required. The traffic to the daycare is generally from 6-8 am and 4:30 – 6:00 pm. The parents who drop off their kids are cautious and drive slow in the area. Ms. Kasper said he recently had the septic pumped and the company said the condition of the septic system is in good running order and only regular maintenance is required. There will not be an additional bathroom in the expansion because the children are not potty trained.

George Malette moved to accept the application as complete; Tom Clow seconded, all voted in favor.

## **Public Comment:**

Eric Niquette, 147 Pine Hill Road – Mr. Niquette says he fully supports the daycare expansion and does not feet that traffic will be a problem.

Tom Clow moved to approve the expansion of the Little Buttercup Nursery as outlined in the application; George Malette seconded, all voted in favor.
