Discussed Article 34.9.2, consensus to remove 34.9.2.

Discussed "directional signs". Proposed article 34.12 to read:

DIRECTIONAL / OFF SITE SIGNS: A business may have an off-site sign for directional purposes only, with approval of the Planning Board. The application to the Code Enforcement Officer must be signed by the landowner. The sign cannot be lit with a maximum height is 8 feet, only 1 sign per business, otherwise by Special Exception.
