FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER

The Weare, New Hampshire Police Department, a candidate agency for CALEA National Accreditation, is seeking qualified community oriented applicants for the position of Full Time Police Officer. The applicant selected to serve as Full Time Police Officer will provide law enforcement and community-oriented services to the second largest municipality in the state.

Officers patrol an assigned area for the purpose of community service, crime prevention and law enforcement. Duties include but are not limited to the investigation of crimes; identification/apprehension of offenders; traffic enforcement and the provision of emergency services. Candidates must have the ability to exercise good judgment/common sense/discretion, and be able to analyze situations quickly and objectively. Applicants must be able to make decisions under pressure.

Applicants must be 21 years old by the anticipated date of appointment. Applicants must be a high school graduate or hold a GED; Bachelor Degrees from an accredited college or university and/or prior military service are preferred. **Full-time New Hampshire certified police officers or any other state accepted by the New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council will be given a written test waiver.**

Weare Police Department will send qualified Full-Time Officer candidates to the police academy, as applicable.
