April 20, 2022

Chairman Hippler called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM in the upstairs conference room at the Town Office. Selectman Cahill stated that the reason this meeting with Jack Dearborn is to be able to make sure the Board had all the information regarding the upgrade of the radio communications for the Board to take it from here. Mr. Dearborn explained the handouts he had. Chairman Hippler stated that there seems to be some confusion about whether the Fire Department has to be included or not. Fire Chief Vezina stated that they didn't have to be. Mr. Dearborn stated that is true, they can go right to Capital Area Mutual Aid and things will work. Vice Chairman Osborne asked the Board for it's stand on the \$1,300 for police coverage during the Patriotic Celebration. The Board agreed that police coverage is necessary during the parade, fireworks and after the
