## CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES AUGUST 8, 2018

**Members present:** Bill Bolton, Sherry Burdick, Lori Davis

**I. Call to order:** Meeting call to order at 7:00 PM by William Bolton.

### **II. Discussion:**

Mr. Bolton motioned to accept the NH Dept. of Environmental Services, Wetland Bureau letter regarding the application for an "Aquatic Resource Mitigation (ARM) grant for funding to protect a 205 +/- tract from Meadowsend Timberlands, Robert French Preserve, Lot 410-8, abutting the west boundary of the Ferrin Pond Town Forest and the Piscataquog Land Conservancy's (PIC) Ferrin Pond Reserve in Weare, New Hampshire as submitted by the Piscataquog Land Conservancy (PLC)." Ms. Burdick seconded and carried without opposition.

Ms. Fisk was welcomed by Mr. Bolton to speak concerning an August 26th fundraiser which hosts a trail horse ride for her group. Ms. Fisk is seeking permission from Town of Weare (TOW) to use the Candlewood Class A Trail, which leads into the Ferrin Pond Loop. Ms. Fisk explained her group is insured and will send documentation to the TOW. Ms. Davis moved to allow use of the trail, Ms. Burdick seconded and motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Bolton welcomed Michael Camacho to speak. He expressed his interest in volunteering on the board. It was discussed that an official induction at the next meeting would be agreed on.
