Final Minutes

Motion to approve the minutes as written was made by John Lawton and seconded by Betty Straw, all voted in favor.

Meg and George will follow up to retrieve information and forms from Adair Mulligan the presenter of the Lyme, NH “the secrets of cellar holes” project.

Betty Straw updated us that the Clinton Grove project is on hold but they will continue to move forward with the roof replacement.

George informed the board that the workshop about understanding and researching historic properties will be presented by Mary Kate Ryan from DHR and is sponsored by the General John Stark Scenic Byway Council is scheduled for the end of September.

Jerry Little has offered to lead the Commission on a site walk to some cellar holes on the Eastman Town Forest property. George will check with Jerry and inform the Commission of the date time and meeting location for the site walk. George will be borrowing the Conservation Commission’s GPS unit to pinpoint the location.

Peaslee Road Bridge historic mitigation: John Lawton informed us that the booklet would costs between \$6,500 and \$8000 (aprox. 85 hours) and that the Town would get 80% of that costs reimbursed by the State. John suggested an alternate historic mitigation option of a sign or a plaque at the site.
