April 8, 2014***

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: ~7:10PM

MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: Jim Blouin, Valerie King, Chuck Metcalf, Melissa Drury, J'Amy Colburn, Randy Magoon, and Mike Housman

COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

- Weare Christian Church submitted a facility use form for Chase Park on April 20th.
- The fields are still snow covered so Mike will hold off on ordering the port-potties until next week, but will start irrigation now.
- Mike is resigning as of May 13th. He provide a list of contacts and general activity dates as a resource for the next Coordinator.
- Discussion about having Chase Park staff do garbage pick-up while the Coordinator position is vacant. Concerns that this may create issues with liability and use of personal vehicles.
- Capital Well will be chlorinating the well at Chase Park next week.
- The gates at Chase Park are in need of repair. Chuck and Mike will take a look and assess what repairs are needed.
- Seniors will be hosting a luncheon in June at Jon McCoslen's rose gardens. Lunch provided by Colburn's. There will be a \$200 cap on expenses. Request approved.
- Brianna will be returning this summer to teach swim lessons. A schedule needs to be developed. Preparations need to be made for sign-ups in May/June.
- Discussion regarding whether PARC should be asking for proof of non-profit status when organizations request use of PARC facilities.
- Still no word from WAC soccer regarding field usage this season. Mike will follow-up.
- PARC will need to have a plan developed before applying for a permit to fix the boat ramp. The plan is to replace the tar with concrete and extend the ramp further into the water. Estimated to cost \$10-\$15,000 to complete.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Its official! Jeremy was approved by the Board of Selectman.
- At voting, there were sign-up sheets where people could indicate if they were interested in joining a town committee. There was a sheet for PARC, but none of the members received a copy. Melissa will ask the town office for a copy. Sandwich boards can also be used to advertise PARC vacancies.
- Valerie will ask Tom Desrosier to return his PARC keys so they can be passed on to incoming members.
- Swim lines need to go out in early June.
- Members are asked to meet on April 19th (Sat) to take down and put away the ice rink.
- J'Amy will follow up with Karen Stogner regarding her interest in joining PARC.
- After 12+ years with PARC, Jim is resigning. May will be his last meeting.
