Shawn Oestreich asked the rules for signage at Bolton. Would like to have removable sponsor signs to raise money. Randy to check with Naomi or Chip.

Karyn reported Keith Lacasse and Tom Downing will attend future meeting regarding plans to build a concession by Bolton playground.

Karyn reported that Hillsboro invested \$10,000. to improve their two fields. Weare Athletic Club is willing to invest \$8,000. in Purington field. Will attend a future meeting to formalize.

Kevin Bishop suggested when Bolton buildings are repainted to use school colors vs. green. Football offered labor to paint if another group will donate paint. Estimate of 15 gallons/\$225.

Peter Stockhaus will manage lawn care for the parks. Discussion regarding park/team needs:

- Spring mow twice per week. July and August mow once per week.
- Football requested mowing on Wednesdays to be able to paint lines for Saturday games. 2 1/2 3 inches.
- Planning to bag clippings every mow.
- Karyn to have irrigation schedule changed to evenings.
- Softball, baseball, soccer daytime weekdays best to mow. 2 inches.
- Lacrosse will contact Peter with schedule and if a home game.
- Responsible for grass, not sand.
- First fertilizer treatment there is a crab grass pre-treatment.
- Aerate and dethatch in September/October all 6 fields in spring.
- Chase Park early best for mowing due to parking. Weed whack every 2-3 weeks. Karyn to give Peter key and Bolton gate code.
- **2. LWCF** (Land and Water Conservation Fund) application for funding for Tennis Court repairs.
 - a. We did not receive the grant.
 - b. Consider a different project for future, e.g. Chase Park.

3. Park Updates

- a. Karyn to call to have Portable toilet removed from Chase Park.
- b. Naomi Bolton to bring for a vote the updated quotes to harvest the trees at Chase Park.
 - Boisvert Brothers least expensive at \$3,500. including removal.

- Trees tagged with green to be trimmed.
- -Trees tagged with orange to be removed.
- d. Jim to replace broken bubble for Bolton playground.

4. Chase Park

Karyn confirmed 5 staff will be returning for Chase Park summer program - 4 positions open, including lifeguard.

Karyn to post In Hippo, Channel 6 and with Mrs. Hume to alert high school students.

April 13 deadline for applications. Review applications at April 14 PARC meeting, then schedule interview dates.

Randy recommended at April meeting we work on Chase staffing schedule. Need to control the expense. Look at donating an old laptop to track attendance.

Unable to reach Brianna regarding whether returning as swim instructor.

Karyn to contact SwimNH to see expense for them to run the program.

Need new umbrella for lifeguard chair.

Chip Meaney has interest from Brett Hadley to fix boat ramp.

- Karyn to get quotes then application for permit.
- Concrete is recommended vs. asphalt.

- a. Melissa solidified Archery classes (Dana White Art of Archery) at Gazebo for August 3-7. Town Hall available for back up in event of rain. \$125. per week/maximum of 10 students. Melissa made a motion to charge \$100. for Weare residents, offsetting \$25. Up to \$250./10 people. Jim second the motion. Four in favor. None opposed.
- b. Karyn shared ideas for activities, including Kayak Day, Field Day with games like cornhole/beanbag toss, Halloween Party, Christmas caroling, bonfire, volleyball at Chase Park. Including other town groups, such as the Fire and/or Police Departments recommended to boost support and attendance.
