Melissa Drury motioned to approve March and April minutes. Tara Mann 2nd motion. All in favor. March & April minutes approved

COORDINATOR'S REPORT/PARK UPDATES

- 1. Weare Community News article will be submitted in late May for June edition. Will focus on JSRHS Varsity Baseball Chase Park cleanup; JSRHS Intersession skate park makeover; Bolton Playground cleanup; thank you to DPW for assistance with playground mulch delivery.
- 2. CIP 2016: Need to Draft RFQ for bath house. Quote received from Townes to fix beach area spring fix: deliver one load of 3/8 screen sand for eroded area and spread at \$450.00 / fall fix: 3 loads of 50/50 sand/loam spread and graded for proper water shed. 2 loads of screen sand for upper area to match new grades for water shed. Seeded and hayed at \$2,000.00. Quote from Bedford Seal Coating for crack repair, seal coating and striping at \$5,000.00.
- 3. Skate Park JSRHS Intersession gave the skate park a face lift with several students and teacher supervisors. Both ramps repainted. Rail constructed. Reconstructed rail box. Area swept and raked. Karyn put signs back up at park. **Still waiting for donation of work on fence.**
- 4. Need to order signs for parks. Trailblazing local signage company Melissa to contact. No Further Information
- 5. Community Service Opportunities: Weare Area Playgroup to possibly organize cleanup of Bolton Playground. Wood chips delivered to Bolton Playground. Will meet at 9:00 AM at the park to start spreading requests for volunteers sent to JSRHS and WAC. Melissa has secured volunteers from Weare Area Playgroup.
- 6. Community Events: 2nd Annual Family Fun Day tabled until further notice.
- 7. Chase Park: Cleanup conducted with JSRHS Varsity Baseball. Interviews for potential employees conducted 5/3/16 to be narrowed down to fill open positions. See CIP information in Paragraph 2 above beach and parking lot work to go forward. RFQ will be submitted for posting on town site. Will need to post the swim instructor position on Swim NH at \$12.50/hour. Well chlorination scheduled

for 5/17/16. WMS 8th grade would like to reserve Chase Park for 6/9/16 for their annual day at the beach – will need to determine if lifeguard available. Supply list submitted to Naomi for park.

- 8. Lawn care: Irrigation is up and running. Received a call from Pete Stockhaus vandalism to baseball storage shed and field area. He was in contact with WPD.
- 9. Seniors: Luncheon will go forward on 5/17/16.
- 10. Miscellaneous: Consider fencing or some other sort of barrier around Ineson field. Will need to determine whether any sprinkler heads were damaged in the spring when irrigation is turned back on.
