

## Transfer Station Information

Traffic is one way around the station for safety reasons , please don't back-up if you miss an area you should go around again;

Only household trash is to be disposed of in the hopper, no recyclables – metal or other non trash items should be disposed of here. Every ton we can remove from trash will save the town \$75 in tipping fees.

Caps must be removed from the plastic that is recycled: this allows more compaction which results in heavier bales;

All corrugated cardboard is recycled including colored or wet

Other cardboard needs to be placed in with the paper, i. e. cereal boxes - soda boxes, etc.

There are separate bins for glass (which also will take toilets and sinks as long as all metal, etc. has been removed), aluminum cans and tin cans (which the paint pails will go)

If you have wood, sheetrock or pressure treated wood you must see an attendant as these carry a disposal fee

Used oil filters and oil are accepted (oil should be in clear containers under five gallons in size) place on table so marked

For all metal please check out the information also on this site, there are many changes here due to our vendor

Any item which has Freon in it has a fee attached to it, doors must be removed from fridges before disposal;

Please see an attendant before leaving items at the swap shop – fee based items aren't allowed;

Items left without payment maybe considered as littering which carries a fine of up to \$250;

The brush pile is for brush only, no lumber may be put here, reason for this is that we are now chipping the brush not burning it. Please see attendant for lumber disposal;

Please check with attendant before disposing of mattresses, couches, etc.;
