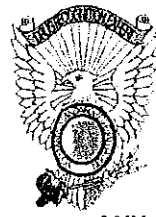

Sir:

I would like to call your attention to a recent drug arrest involving two of our patrol officers. On 04/23/2008, Officers Andrew Shortt and Frank Hebert initiated a motor vehicle stop of a suspect for a speeding violation. The suspect is known to the Weare Police Department for being actively involved in the possession and sales of marijuana.

When the officers were making their approach to the suspect vehicle, they observed the defendant trying to destroy evidence (marijuana). After obtaining voluntary consent to search the vehicle, the officers located a hidden compartment under the stereo system, which contained several bags of marijuana. They also seized approximately \$880.00 dollars in cash deemed to be part of drug sales.

The effort put forth by these officers is commendable. Their diligence in looking beyond the traffic violation was instrumental not only in the arrest of a known drug dealer but also the forfeiture of over \$800.00 in drug money.
