## LOCAL POLICE OFFICER COMPLETES MID-MANAGEMENT COURSE AT ROGER WILLIAMS UNIVERSITY

BRISTOL, R.I., October 20, 2017- The Justice System Training and Research Institute at Roger Williams University in Bristol, R.I., in partnership with the New England Association of Chiefs of Police, recently recognized Sergeant Brandon Montplaisir of the Weare, NH Police Department for the successful completion of the "Command Training Series: Mid-Management Course," a two-week comprehensive training program for upper-level personnel.

Coursework addressed contemporary concepts of management and leadership relevant to the responsibilities of first line supervisors in a modern police agency.
