

**CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES PROHIBITED**


Pursuant to RSA 47:17, VII, RSA 41:11, and in order to protect the general welfare of the Town of Weare under RSA 31:39, the Board of Selectmen hereby adopt the following ordinance:


It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or consume in an open can, bottle, or other container, any alcoholic beverage or alcoholic liquor as defined by RSA 175:1, upon any public way as defined by RSA 259:125, or while on any public sidewalk, municipal parking lot, or municipal park or common, while within the boundaries of the Town of Weare.


This provision shall not apply to that portion of the highway, sidewalk, municipal sidewalk, municipal park or common that has been specifically leased to any private individual or concern for the purpose of establishing an outdoor restaurant or cafe, providing said restaurant or cafe meets all the requirements established by the Town of Weare.

Any person who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a "Violation" and subject to a fine of up to five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.


