Other Initial Costs

- Light bar/internal radio - anticipated to be approximately \$3,000.
- External Radio with antenna - approximately \$6,500
- Graphics - \$800
- Safety Gear -2 Helmets \$750
- Optional Enclosed trailer - approximately \$8,000
 - Weare Fire Department currently has an enclosed trailer which stores their casualty sled which would support storage/transport of UTV.

Annual Costs

- All costs can be funded utilizing Everett Dam Patrol funding. Lines would be reimbursed
 - The PD earns approximately \$6-8k annually.
- Fuel
 - Line 635 (Incorporated within current budget)
- Insurance
 - \$300-\$400/year (Primex)
- Yearly Maintenance- Paid from Line 661
 - DPW Interim Director Fiske has extensive knowledge on UTV and can support maintenance on vehicle.
 - HK Power Sport anticipates \$300/year
 - Hooksett PD- \$80 tune up last year
 - Dunbarton Fire- \$250/year

Hopkinton-Everett Trail System

- Dates open: Late May through late November
- This popular ATV area offers approximately 26 miles of narrow wooded trails and designated single track motorcycle loops. During winter, there is over 30 miles of designated snowmobile trails. Additionally, Weare Winter Wanderers has approximately 65 miles of trails, 80 miles if you include Deering.

Hopkinton-Everett Trail System

- Access trails on private property have been closed due to the actions of a few irresponsible users who do not respect the landowner's property.
- WPD has been unable to address landowner's concerns and hold riders accountable.
- **Maximum Vehicle Width on Trails: 50 inches**
- Clough State Park – 150 acres

Ferrin Pond

- 3 complaints at Ferrin Pond in last 5 months
- 37 OHRV complaints in last 2 years within Town
- **This is not a toy. It is a piece of equipment law enforcement can utilize to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of addressing citizen concerns and calls for service.**

Benefit to Acquiring Equipment

- Weare is one of the busiest ATV towns in the state according to F&G. Patrols in Clough and Ferrin Pond net police contacts for safety violations, shooting violations, and littering. Furthermore, positive interactions can occur on the trail systems with responsible riders.
- Allows for Police/Fire to attend ATV/snowmobile crashes on trails which would have required a longer response time when walking to scene due to limited cruiser access.

Revenue Potential

➤ Fish and Game Grants

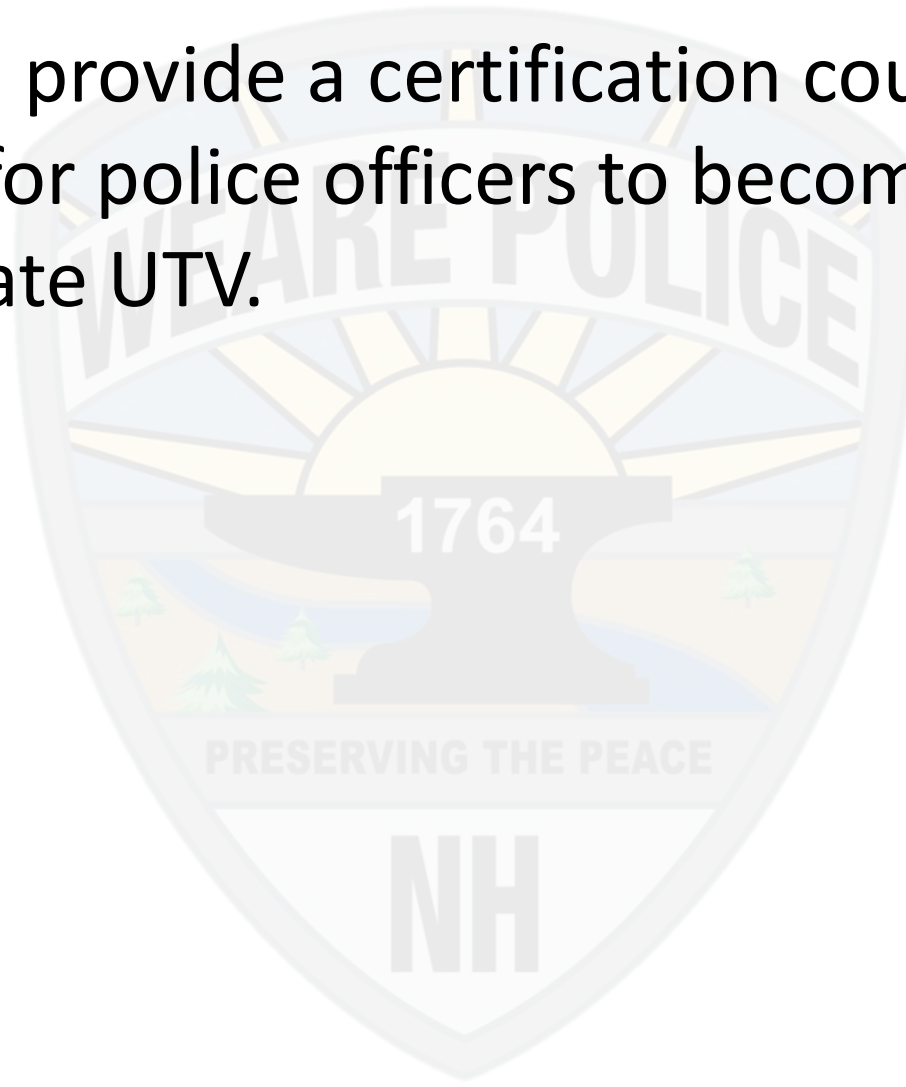
- The OHRV PD Grant (\$40,000 annually) for police patrols is disseminated to Municipal, County and State (Forest & Lands) agencies across the state.

➤ Fish and Game Summons

- If a municipality writes a Fish & Game violation, they receive any balance of fines levied after court fees have been paid.

UTV License Certification

- NH F&G provide a certification course free of charge for police officers to become certified to operate UTV.



End of Life Cycle Management

- Currently there is no life cycle replacement plan in place.
- Maintenance/repair costs can be covered by funds earned during summer/winter patrols at Clough State Park (generally \$6k-\$8k annually). The funding agent is the US Army Corps or Engineers.
- The life cycle is anticipated to be at a minimum of 10 years if proper maintenance occurs.

Mutual Aid Partner Resources

➤ Hillsboro Fire and Police

- Both are over 60" wide

➤ New Boston Fire

- 58" wide

➤ Goffstown Fire

- Does not have OHRV. 1764

➤ Dunbarton Fire

- Kawasaki Mule – over 50" wide.

➤ Henniker Fire

- 70" wide

No Mutual Aid partners will be able to get onto trail system in Clough in event of critical incident. They are all too wide to get past the gates (50" Limit).
