## **Public Hearing for:**

<u>Application for a variance</u> from Jeffrey Ardini for an ADU (Accessory Dwelling Unit) in accordance with Article 19.1.10. to increase the size permitted. (Allow an 855 square foot ADU instead of 750 square feet which is permitted). The property is at 8 Greenwood Road, Tax Map 412, lot 82 in the Residential Zone.

AND CONTINUATION of Application for a special exception for Belanger Construction/(owner) Jeffrey Ardini for an ADU (Accessory Dwelling Unit) in accordance with Article 19.1.10., allowed by Special Exception. The property is at 8 Greenwood Road, Tax Map 412, lot 82 in the Residential Zone. The applicant would like to construct an addition for an ADU.

<u>CONTINUATION of Application for a variance</u> for Sandra and Scott Martel for a variance for required front setback distance. Article 3, section 3.5.1 (Nonconforming use setbacks). The property is on 124 East Shore Drive, Tax Map 104, lot 12 in the Residential Zone. The applicant would like to construct a new two car garage to be no closer than 13 feet from front setback where 30-foot setback is required.

<u>Application for a Special Exception</u> for Alex Heafield for residential use in the commercial district. Article 3.4.2 allows the Zoning Board to permit the resumption of said non-conforming use by public hearing special exception. The property is on 197 South Sugar Hill Road, Tax Map 406, lot 4 in the Commercial Zone. The applicant would like to renovate an existing use for a residential home use.
